## ● MULTI-MODAL NETWORK Scindia urges Centre, states to work together for Gati Shakti success

THE MULTI-MODAL connectivity envisaged under "PM Gati Shakti" will be achieved if the Centre and all the 36 states and Union territories work together, aviation minister Jyotiraditya Scindia said on Monday.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched "PM Gati Shakti - National Master Plan" on August 15 last year to develop multi-modal connectivity through integrated planning and coordinated implementation of infrastructure connectivity projects.

A total of 16 Union ministries, including the railways and the roadways ministries, have been brought under the plan.

"Gati Shakti is not a scheme, but it is an initiative, a foundation. But it will not be an exaggeration if I say that it is a 'brahmastra'," Scindia said at an event here.

It is a "brahmastra" (powerful weapon) that will take India to the destination that the country's forefathers dreamt about, he added. Approximately 12-13% of the country's GDP is spent on logistics currently, Scindia noted.



A family is happy when every member carries out his duties, he said, adding that similarly, under Gati Shakti, 16 departments have been tied together so that each fulfils its responsibilities and uses resources judiciously to achieve its targets.

The National Master Plan will have a multiplier effect on the lives of people, the minister noted.

He said words like "gati" (speed) and "shakti" (strength) have been added to the country's dictionary after a gap of 70 years. The investments made by the United States in multi-modal logistics in the last 100 years has turned it into a super power, Scindia said.

"If we could bring all 36 states to work together and if we could develop coordination so that there is no delay in getting the requisite permissions, we will be able to achieve the aim of multi-modal connectivity," he added.

## ISMA revises upwards sugar output at 314.5 LT in 2021-22; export up at 16 LT in Oct-Dec

INDIA'S SUGAR PRODUCTION estimate has been revised upward by 3% to 314.5 lakh tonne (LT) for 2021-22 marketing year ending September as against the earlier forecast of 305 lakh tonne, according to industry body ISMA.

Sugar output stood at 311.8 lakh tonne in the 2020-21 season.

Releasing its second advance estimates, Indian Sugar Mills Association (ISMA) said, "The country is expected to produce 314.50 lakh tonne of sugar during 2021-22 season." Sugar marketing year runs from October to September.

"This is after considering an estimated diversion of sugar equivalent of 34 lakh tonne for production of ethanol by means of diversion of sugarcane juice



/syrup or B-heavy molasses," the association said in a statement on Monday.

Sugar production in Uttar Pradesh is seen at 102 lakh tonne in 2021-22 as against 110.59 lakh tonne in the previous year due to lower cane yields and lower sugar recoveries along with much higher diversion of sugar for production of ethanol

by way of diversion of B heavy molasses and sugarcane juice.

It is estimated that about 12.55 lakh tonne of sugar will be diverted for ethanol production by the sugar mills in UP in the current year as compared to about 6.90 lakh tonne diverted in 2020-21.

Maharashtra is expected to produce about 117 lakh tonne

in 2021-22 as against 106.50 lakh tonne produced in 2020-21.

Higher estimated sugar production this year is mainly due to increased cane area by about 11% and better cane yields and sugar recovery as compared to the last season.

"This is owing to favourable weather conditions as well as increase in percentage of ratoon cane, which helps in better recovery," ISMA said.

Based on the allocations made by the OMCs for supply of ethanol in 2021-22 so far and expected to be allocated in the current season, it is estimated that sugar mills in Maharashtra will divert about 11.27 lakh tonnes of sugar equivalent for production of ethanol in the current year, which is much higher as compared to about 7.12 lakh tonnes diverted in 2020-21.

## Joshi: No need for separate discussion on Pegasus issue now, matter sub judice

PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS MINISTER Pralhad Joshi on Monday said there is no need for a separate discussion on the Pegasus issue now as the matter is sub-judice. However, if opposition parties want they can raise any issue while speaking on the Motion of Thanks on the president's address, he said.

Parliamentary affairs minister Pralhad Joshi said opposition leaders are free to raise any issue while speaking on the Motion of Thanks on the President's address

Addressing reporters after an all-party meeting held virtually, Joshi said the floor leaders of 25 parties attended the

meeting in which the government was represented by defence minister and deputy leader of Lok Sabha Rajnath Singh. Joshi said Singh sought cooperation from all parties for smooth functioning of the House during the Budget Session. As far as the Pegasus issue is concerned, he said, there is no need for a separate discussion now, but opposition leaders are free to raise any issue while speaking on the Motion

of Thanks on the President's address. The Budget session of Parliament began on Monday and is scheduled to conclude on April 8 with a recess in-between from February 12 to March 13.

The Pegasus issue was reignited after a recent *New York Times* report claimed that India bought the Pegasus spyware as part of a \$2 billion defence deal with Israel in 2017.

## Nobody losing anything due to vax mandates: Centre tells apex court

THE CENTRE ON Monday opposed in the Supreme Court the arguments that people are losing their jobs and rations allegedly due to the Covid-19 vaccine mandates issued by various states and authorities, saying nobody is "losing anything".

Solicitor general Tushar Mehta told this to a Bench comprising Justices L Nageswara Rao

and B R Gavai that was hearing a matter in which issues including disclosure of data on clinical trials of Covid-19 vaccines and vaccine mandates have been raised.

Advocate Prashant Bhushan, appearing for the petitioner, said the aspect of vaccine mandates being issued by several states and other authorities is urgent as people are losing their jobs. Right now, what is urgent is the vaccine mandate because

people are losing their jobs. They are losing their rations. They are not able to move around freely as a result of these vaccine mandates," Bhushan said.

Mehta told the Bench that the petitioner has filed an application in the matter claiming that people are losing their jobs due to this. "Mr Bhushan filed an IA that many people are losing their jobs etc. Nobody is losing anything and nobody has come before your lordships," Mehta

said. During the hearing, the Bench told Bhushan that all these instances, which the petitioner is bringing to its notice, might not be possible for the court to decide because there may be numerous situations. The Bench said it would hear the matter finally and then decide it.

"Today, the situation is that people are losing their jobs," Bhushan said.

The Bench said there may be

so many situations and specific issues can be dealt with by the respective high courts.

Referring to the issue of vaccine mandates, Bhushan said various authorities are restricting all kinds of fundamental rights of the citizens by these mandates.

Bhushan said he was not arguing that vaccine mandate cannot be issued at all.

He said an individual has to weigh in the pros and cons of

vaccine, its benefits and then decide on it for himself or herself. He said such mandate can be issued only if there is clear evidence that not taking the vaccine makes an individual a much greater danger to others, than after taking the vaccine.

Bhushan said there is evidence to show that if a person had the infection, his or her protection from the infection is far superior than any protection that the vaccine might give.

## HC to DMRC: Take clear instructions on paying arbitral award to DAMEPL

THE DELHI HIGH Court Monday asked the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) counsel to take clear instructions on how it will pay the amount of the arbitral award of over ₹4,600 crore to Reliance Infrastructure's subsidiary DAMEPL or else face an "unpleasant order".

Justice Suresh Kumar Kait preponed the date of hearing relating to the execution of the arbitral award passed against the DMRC, from March 29 to February 14.

"Mr. (Parag) Tripathi (counsel for DMRC), on the next date of hearing, I don't want to hear anything here or there. You have to take clear instructions on how to pay the amount. This liability, that liability will not work otherwise you will face an unpleasant order," the judge said.

DMRC counsel assured the court that they will not seek any further accommodation. The high court was adjudicating an early hearing application filed by DAMEPL in pursuance of the Supreme Court's January 24 order.

"The parties are directed to appear before the high court on January 31 and seek for advancing the date of hearing. We request the high court to take up the matter at the earliest and dispose of the execution application without any further delay, as consequences of pendency of this application are detrimental to the interest of the petitioner as well as the respondent," the apex court had said in its order while disposing of the appeal filed by DAMEPL challenging the high court's January 11 order.

On January 11, the high court had pulled up decree-holder DAMEPL for playing "hide and seek" with the court and holding out-of-court communications with judgement debtor DMRC to settle the dispute while arguing before the court that it was not ready to accept the proposal made by the PSU. Reliance Infrastructure's subsidiary had filed an application claiming that DMRC was deliberately trying to delay the execution of the over ₹4,600 crore arbitral award against it, which was costing the taxpayer a daily interest of almost ₹1.75 crore.

## HC to DMRC: Take clear instructions on paying arbitral award to DAMEPL

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# HC to DMRC: Take clear instructions on paying arbitral award to DAMEPL

New Delhi, January 31

**THE DELHI HIGH** Court Monday asked the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) counsel to take clear instructions on how it will pay the amount of the arbitral award of over ₹4,600 crore to Reliance Infrastructure's subsidiary DAMEPL or else face an "unpleasant order."

Justice Suresh Kumar Kait preponed the date of hearing relating to the execution of the arbitral award passed against the DMRC, from March 29 to February 14.

"Mr. (Parag) Tripathi (counsel for DMRC), on the next date of hearing, I don't want to hear anything here or there. You have to take clear instructions on how to pay the amount. This liability,

that liability will not work otherwise you will face an unpleasant order," the judge said.

DMRC counsel assured the court that they will not seek any further accommodation. The high court was adjudicating an early hearing application filed by DAMEPL, in pursuance of the Supreme Court's January 24 order.

"The parties are directed to appear before the high court on January 31 and seek for advancing the date of hearing. We request the high court to take up the matter at the earliest and dispose of the execution application without any further delay, as consequences of pendency of this application are detrimental to the interest of the petitioner as well as the respondent," the apex court



had said in its order while disposing of the appeal filed by DAMEPL challenging the high court's January 11 order.

On January 11, the high court had pulled up decreeholder DAMEPL for playing "hide and seek" with the court and holding out-of-court communications with judgement debtor DMRC to settle the dispute while arguing before the court that it was not ready to

accept the proposal made by the PSU.

Reliance Infrastructure's subsidiary had filed an application claiming that DMRC was deliberately trying to delay the execution of the over ₹4,600 crore arbitral award against it, which was costing the taxpayer a daily interest of almost ₹1.75 crore.

An arbitral tribunal in its May 2017 award had ruled in favour of DAMEPL, which had pulled out from running the Airport Express metro line over safety issues, and accepted its claim that the running of operations on the line was not viable due to structural defects in the viaduct through which the train would run.

In December last year, DAMEPL's counsel had told the

court that as per DMRC's affidavit, it had over ₹5,800 crore in its bank accounts as of December 17, 2021, with over ₹1,642 crore being its earning and over ₹2,400 crore and ₹1,700 crore being its project allocation fund and deposit fund, respectively. DMRC had stated that since the corporation was facing a "financial crunch", undertaking a "sudden liability" would impact public interest and authorities were therefore working out a solution. It had earlier told the court that it would deposit ₹1,000 crore in favour of DAMEPL in an escrow account.

The award pertained to a concession agreement between the two entities, which was signed on August 25, 2008. Under the agreement, DMRC

was to carry out the civil works, excluding at the depot, and the balance, including the project system works, were to be executed by DAMEPL, a joint venture of R-Infra and a Spanish construction company - Construcciones Y Auxiliares De Ferrocarriles - with a shareholding of 95% and 5% respectively.

# Power sector workers to hold nationwide protest today against privatisation

**ALL INDIA POWER** Engineers Federation (AIPEF) has said power sector workers will hold a nationwide protest against privatisation policies on Tuesday.

"On the call of National Coordination Committee of Electricity Employees & Engineers (NCCOEEE) Power Employees & Engineers across the country will hold protest demonstrations against privatisation policies of Central Government," an AIPEF statement said.

NCCOEEE has also decided that core committee leaders of NCCOEEE will meet the Punjab Governor on February 1 and hand over a memorandum to him against the privatisation of Chandigarh UT Power Department. NCCOEEE core committee office bearers will address the strike rally of Puducherry power employees on February 2 at Puducherry.

AIPEF Chairman Shailendra Dubey said, "On-call of NCCOEEE about 1.5 million Power Employees & Engineers across the country will hold nationwide protest/ demon-

strations on February 1 at all district headquarters and projects against privatisation policies of Central Government".

The main demand of Power Employees & Engineers are - withdraw Electricity (Amendment) Bill 2021, scrap decision of privatisation of profit-making power departments of Union Territories -- Chandigarh, Dadra Nagar Haveli Daman & Diu and Puducherry, integrate all unbundled power utilities in states like KSEB Ltd in Kerala and HPSEB Ltd in Himachal Pradesh, implement old pension scheme for all power employees recruited after unbundling of SEBs, regularise all outsourced power employees as the Telangana government has done, he added. Dubey said that NCCOEEE core committee leaders will reach Chandigarh on February 1 to support UT Power Employees Strike against privatisation. The leaders will meet the governor on February 1 and submit a memorandum to him against the privatisation of the profit-making power department. —PTI

# Nobody losing anything due to vax mandates: Centre tells apex court

**THE CENTRE ON** Monday opposed in the Supreme Court the arguments that people are losing their jobs and rations allegedly due to the Covid-19 vaccine mandates issued by various states and authorities, saying nobody is "losing anything".

Solicitor general Tushar Mehta told this to a Bench comprising Justices L. Nageswara Rao and B.R. Gavai that was hearing a matter in which issues including disclosure of data on clinical trials of Covid-19 vaccines and vaccine mandates have been raised.

Advocate Prashant Bhushan, appearing for the petitioner, said the aspect of vaccine mandates being issued by several states and other authorities is urgent as people are losing their jobs.

"Right now, what is urgent is the vaccine mandate because people are losing their jobs. They are losing their rations. They are not able to move around freely as a result of these vaccine mandates," Bhushan said.

Mehta told the Bench that the petitioner has filed an application in the matter claiming that people are losing their jobs due to this.

"Mr Bhushan filed an IA that many people are losing their jobs etc. Nobody is losing anything and nobody has come before your lordships," Mehta said.

During the hearing, the Bench told Bhushan that all these instances, which the petitioner is bringing to its notice, might not be possible for the court to decide because there may be numerous situations.

The Bench said it would hear the matter finally and then decide it.

"Today, the situation is that people are losing their jobs," Bhushan said.

The Bench said there may be so many situations and specific issues can be dealt with by the respective high courts.

Referring to the issue of vaccine mandates, Bhushan said various authorities are restricting all kinds of fundamental rights of the citizens by these mandates.

Bhushan said he was not arguing that vaccine mandate cannot be issued at all.

He said an individual has to weigh in the pros and cons of vaccine, its benefits and then decide on it for himself or herself.

He said such mandate can be issued only if there is clear evidence that not taking the vaccine makes an individual a much greater danger to others, than after taking the vaccine.

Bhushan said there is evidence to show that if a person had the infection, his or her protection from the infection is far superior than any protection that the vaccine might give. The Bench said it will list the matter for hearing finally and decide it.

"The apex court had in August last year asked the Centre, Bharat Biotech, Serum Institute of India and others to respond to the plea seeking directions for disclosure of data on clinical trials of Covid-19 vaccines as also on post-job cases. Bhushan had then told the court that it was not an "anti-vaccine petition" and transparency on the issue was needed.

# Joshi: No need for separate discussion on Pegasus issue, matter sub judice

# Scindia urges Centre, states to work together for Gati Shakti success

**THE MULTI-MODAL** connectivity envisaged under "PM Gati Shakti" will be achieved if the Centre and all the 36 states and Union territories work together, aviation minister Jyotiraditya Scindia said on Monday.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched "PM Gati Shakti - National Master Plan" on August 15 last year to develop multi-modal connectivity through integrated planning and coordinated implementation of infrastructure connectivity projects.

"Gati Shakti is not a scheme, but it is an initiative, a foundation. But it will not be an exaggeration if I say that it is a 'brahmastra'," Scindia said at an event here.

It is a "brahmastra" (powerful weapon) that will take India to the destination that the country's forefathers dreamt about, he added. Approximately 12-13% of the country's GDP is

spent on logistics currently, Scindia noted.

A family is happy when every member carries out his duties, he said, adding that similarly, under Gati Shakti, 16 departments have been tied together so that each fulfils its responsibilities and uses resources judiciously to achieve its targets.

The National Master Plan will have a multiplier effect on the lives of people, the minister noted.

He said words like "gati" (speed) and "shakti" (strength) have been added to the country's dictionary after a gap of 70 years. The investments made by the United States in multi-modal logistics in the last 100 years has turned it into a super power, Scindia said.

"If we could bring all 36 states to work together and if we could develop coordination so that there is no delay in getting the requisite permissions, we will be able to achieve the aim of multi-modal connectivity," he added.

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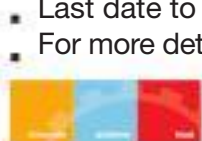

# HC to DMRC: Take clear instructions on paying arbitral award to DAMEPL

New Delhi, January 31

THE DELHI HIGH Court Monday asked the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) counsel to take clear instructions on how it will pay the amount of the arbitral award of over ₹4,600 crore to Reliance Infrastructure's subsidiary DAMEPL or else face an "unpleasant order."

Justice Suresh Kumar Kait preponed the date of hearing relating to the execution of the arbitral award passed against the DMRC, from March 29 to February 14.

"Mr. (Parag) Tripathi (counsel for DMRC), on the next date of hearing, I don't want to hear anything here or there. You have to take clear instructions on how to pay the amount. This liability,

that liability will not work otherwise you will face an unpleasant order," the judge said.

DMRC counsel assured the court that they will not seek any further accommodation. The high court was adjudicating an early hearing application filed by DAMEPL, in pursuance of the Supreme Court's January 24 order.

"The parties are directed to appear before the high court on January 31 and seek for advancing the date of hearing. We request the high court to take up the matter at the earliest and dispose of the execution application without any further delay, as consequences of pendency of this application are detrimental to the interest of the petitioner as well as the respondent," the apex court



had said in its order while disposing of the appeal filed by DAMEPL challenging the high court's January 11 order.

On January 11, the high court had pulled up decreeholder DAMEPL for playing "hide and seek" with the court and holding out-of-court communications with judgement debtor DMRC to settle the dispute while arguing before the court that it was not ready to

accept the proposal made by the PSU.

Reliance Infrastructure's subsidiary had filed an application claiming that DMRC was deliberately trying to delay the execution of the over ₹4,600 crore arbitral award against it, which was costing the taxpayer a daily interest of almost ₹1.75 crore.

An arbitral tribunal in its May 2017 award had ruled in favour of DAMEPL, which had pulled out from running the Airport Express metro line over safety issues, and accepted its claim that the running of operations on the line was not viable due to structural defects in the viaduct through which the train would run.

In December last year, DAMEPL's counsel had told the

court that as per DMRC's affidavit, it had over ₹5,800 crore in its bank accounts as of December 17, 2021, with over ₹1,642 crore being its earning and over ₹2,400 crore and ₹1,700 crore being its project allocation fund and deposit fund, respectively. DMRC had stated that since the corporation was facing a "financial crunch", undertaking a "sudden liability" would impact public interest and authorities were therefore working out a solution. It had earlier told the court that it would deposit ₹1,000 crore in favour of DAMEPL in an escrow account.

The award pertained to a concession agreement between the two entities, which was signed on August 25, 2008. Under the agreement, DMRC

was to carry out the civil works, excluding at the depot, and the balance, including the project system works, were to be executed by DAMEPL, a joint venture of R-Infra and a Spanish construction company - Construcciones Y Auxiliares De Ferrocarriles - with a shareholding of 95% and 5% respectively.

# Power sector workers to hold nationwide protest today against privatisation

ALL INDIA POWER Engineers Federation (AIPEF) has said power sector workers will hold a nationwide protest against privatisation policies on Tuesday.

"On the call of National Coordination Committee of Electricity Employees & Engineers (NCCOEEE) Power Employees & Engineers across the country will hold protest demonstrations against privatisation policies of Central Government," an AIPEF statement said.

NCCOEEE has also decided that core committee leaders of NCCOEEE will meet the Punjab Governor on February 1 and hand over a memorandum to him against the privatisation of Chandigarh UT Power Department. NCCOEEE core committee office bearers will address the strike rally of Puducherry power employees on February 2 at Puducherry.

AIPEF Chairman Shailendra Dubey said, "On-call of NCCOEEE about 1.5 million Power Employees & Engineers across the country will hold nationwide protest/ demon-

strations on February 1 at all district headquarters and projects against privatisation policies of Central Government".

The main demand of Power Employees & Engineers are - withdraw Electricity (Amendment) Bill 2021, scrap decision of privatisation of profit-making power departments of Union Territories -- Chandigarh, Dadra Nagar Haveli Daman & Diu and Puducherry, integrate all unbundled power utilities in states like KSEB Ltd in Kerala and HPSEB Ltd in Himachal Pradesh, implement old pension scheme for all power employees recruited after unbundling of SEBs, regularise all outsourced power employees as the Telangana government has done, he added. Dubey said that NCCOEEE core committee leaders will reach Chandigarh on February 1 to support UT Power Employees Strike against privatisation. The leaders will meet the governor on February 1 and submit a memorandum to him against the privatisation of the profit-making power department. —PTI

# Nobody losing anything due to vax mandates: Centre tells apex court

THE CENTRE ON Monday opposed in the Supreme Court the arguments that people are losing their jobs and rations allegedly due to the Covid-19 vaccine mandates issued by various states and authorities, saying nobody is "losing anything".

Solicitor general Tushar Mehta told this to a Bench comprising Justices L. Nageswara Rao and B.R. Gavai that was hearing a matter in which issues including disclosure of data on clinical trials of Covid-19 vaccines and vaccine mandates have been raised.

Advocate Prashant Bhushan, appearing for the petitioner, said the aspect of vaccine mandates being issued by several states and other authorities is urgent as people are losing their jobs.

"Right now, what is urgent is the vaccine mandate because people are losing their jobs. They are losing their rations. They are not able to move around freely as a result of these vaccine mandates," Bhushan said.

Mehta told the Bench that the petitioner has filed an application in the matter claiming that people are losing their jobs due to this.

"Mr Bhushan filed an IA that many people are losing their jobs etc. Nobody is losing anything and nobody has come before your lordships," Mehta said.

During the hearing, the Bench told Bhushan that all these instances, which the petitioner is bringing to its notice, might not be possible for the court to decide because there may be numerous situations.

The Bench said it would hear the matter finally and then decide it.

"Today, the situation is that people are losing their jobs," Bhushan said.

The Bench said there may be so many situations and specific issues can be dealt with by the respective high courts.

Referring to the issue of vaccine mandates, Bhushan said various authorities are restricting all kinds of fundamental rights of the citizens by these mandates.

Bhushan said he was not arguing that vaccine mandate cannot be issued at all.

He said an individual has to weigh in the pros and cons of vaccine, its benefits and then decide on it for himself or herself.

He said such mandate can be issued only if there is clear evidence that not taking the vaccine makes an individual a much greater danger to others, than after taking the vaccine.

Bhushan said there is evidence to show that if a person had the infection, his or her protection from the infection is far superior than any protection that the vaccine might give. The Bench said it will list the matter for hearing finally and decide it.

The apex court had in August last year asked the Centre, Bharat Biotech, Serum Institute of India and others to respond to the plea seeking directions for disclosure of data on clinical trials of Covid-19 vaccines as also on post-jab cases. Bhushan had then told the court that it was not an "anti-vaccine petition" and transparency on the issue was needed.

# Joshi: No need for separate discussion on Pegasus issue, matter sub judice

# Scindia urges Centre, states to work together for Gati Shakti success

THE MULTI-MODAL connectivity envisaged under "PM Gati Shakti" will be achieved if the Centre and all the 36 states and Union territories work together, aviation minister Jyotiraditya Scindia said on Monday.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched "PM Gati Shakti - National Master Plan" on August 15 last year to develop multi-modal connectivity through integrated planning and coordinated implementation of infrastructure connectivity projects.

"Gati Shakti is not a scheme, but it is an initiative, a foundation. But it will not be an exaggeration if I say that it is a 'brahmastra'," Scindia said at an event here.

It is a "brahmastra" (powerful weapon) that will take India to the destination that the country's forefathers dreamt about, he added. Approximately 12-13% of the country's GDP is

spent on logistics currently, Scindia noted.

A family is happy when every member carries out his duties, he said, adding that similarly, under Gati Shakti, 16 departments have been tied together so that each fulfils its responsibilities and uses resources judiciously to achieve its targets.

The National Master Plan will have a multiplier effect on the lives of people, the minister noted.

He said words like "gati" (speed) and "shakti" (strength) have been added to the country's dictionary after a gap of 70 years. The investments made by the United States in multi-modal logistics in the last 100 years has turned it into a super power, Scindia said.

"If we could bring all 36 states to work together and if we could develop coordination so that there is no delay in getting the requisite permissions, we will be able to achieve the aim of multi-modal connectivity," he added.

**THE CENTRE ON** Monday opposed in the Supreme Court the arguments that people are losing their jobs and rations allegedly due to the Covid-19 vaccine mandates issued by various states and authorities, saying nobody is "losing anything".

Solicitor general Tushar Mehta told this to a Bench comprising Justices L. Nageswara Rao and B.R. Gavai that was hearing a matter in which issues including disclosure of data on clinical trials of Covid-19 vaccines and vaccine mandates have been raised.

Advocate Prashant Bhusan, appearing for the petitioner, said the aspect of vaccine mandates being issued by several states and other authorities is urgent as people are losing their jobs.

"Right now, what is urgent is the vaccine mandate because people are losing their jobs. They are losing their rations. They are not able to move around freely as a result of these vaccine mandates," Bhusan said.

Mehta told the Bench that the petitioner has filed an application in the matter claiming that people are losing their jobs due to this.

"Mr Bhusan filed an IA that many people are losing their jobs etc. Nobody is losing anything and nobody has come before your lordships," Mehta said.

During the hearing, the Bench told Bhusan that all these instances, which the petitioner is bringing to its notice, might not be possible for the court to decide because there may be numerous situations.

The Bench said it would hear the matter finally and then decide it.

"Today, the situation is that people are losing their jobs," Bhusan said.

The Bench said there may be so many situations and specific issues can be dealt with by the respective high courts.

Referring to the issue of vaccine mandates, Bhusan said various authorities are restricting all kinds of fundamental rights of the citizens by these mandates.

Bhusan said he was not arguing that vaccine mandate cannot be issued at all.

He said an individual has to weigh in the pros and cons of vaccine, its benefits and then decide on it for himself or herself.

He said such mandate can be issued only if there is clear evidence that not taking the vaccine makes an individual a much greater danger to others, than after taking the vaccine.

Bhusan said there is evidence to show that if a person had the infection, his or her protection from the infection is far superior than any protection that the vaccine might give. The Bench said it will list the matter for hearing finally and decide it.

The apex court had in August last year asked the Centre, Bharat Biotech, Serum Institute of India and others to respond to the plea seeking directions for disclosure of data on clinical trials of Covid-19 vaccines as also on post-job cases. Bhusan had then told the court that it was not an "anti-vaccine petition" and transparency on the issue was needed.

"Gati Shakti is not a scheme, but it is an initiative, a foundation. But it will not be an exaggeration if I say that it is a 'brahmastra'," Scindia said at an event here.

It is a "brahmastra" (powerful weapon) that will take India to the destination that the country's forefathers dreamt about, he added. Approximately 12-13% of the country's GDP is

spent on logistics currently, Scindia noted.

A family is happy when every member carries out his duties, he said, adding that similarly, under Gati Shakti, 16 departments have been tied together so that each fulfils its responsibilities and uses resources judiciously to achieve its targets.

The National Master Plan will have a multiplier effect on the lives of people, the minister noted.

He said words like "gati" (speed) and "shakti" (strength) have been added to the country's dictionary after a gap of 70 years. The investments made by the United States in multi-modal logistics in the last 100 years has turned it into a super power, Scindia said.

"If we could bring all 36 states to work together and if we could develop coordination so that there is no delay in getting the requisite permissions, we will be able to achieve the aim of multi-modal connectivity," he added.

**THE DELHI HIGH COURT** Monday asked the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) counsel to take clear instructions on how it will pay the amount of the arbitral award of over ₹4,600 crore to Reliance Infrastructure's subsidiary DAMEPL or else face an "unpleasant order."



Justice Suresh Kumar Kait preponed the date of hearing relating to the execution of the arbitral award passed against the DMRC, from March 29 to February 14.

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DMRC counsel assured the court that they will not seek any further accommodation. The high court was adjudicating an early hearing application filed by DAMEPL, in pursuance of the Supreme Court's January 24 or-

der. "The parties are directed to appear before the high court on January 31 and seek for advancing the date of hearing. We request the high court to take up the matter at the earliest and dispose of the execution application without any further delay, as consequences of pendency of this application are detrimental to the interest of the petitioner as well as the respondent," the apex court had said in its order while disposing of the appeal filed by DAMEPL challenging the high court's January 11 order.

On January 11, the high court had pulled up decreed-holder DAMEPL for playing "hide and seek" with the court and holding out-of-court communications with judgement debtor DMRC to settle the dispute while arguing before the court that it was not ready to accept the proposal made by the PSU.

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An arbitral tribunal in its May 2017 award had ruled in favour of DAMEPL, which had pulled out from running the Airport Express metro line over safety issues, and accepted its claim that the running of operations on the line was not viable due to structural defects in the viaduct through which the train would run.

In December last year, DAMEPL's counsel had told the court that as per DMRC's affidavit, it had over ₹5,800 crore in its bank accounts as of December 17, 2021, with over ₹1,642 crore being its earning and over ₹2,400 crore and ₹1,700 crore being its project

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# MULTI-MODAL NETWORK Scindia urges Centre, states to work together for Gati Shakti success

New Delhi, January 31

THE MULTI-MODAL connectivity envisaged under "PM Gati Shakti" will be achieved if the Centre and all the 36 states and Union territories work together, aviation minister Jyotiraditya Scindia said on Monday.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched "PM Gati Shakti - National Master Plan" on August 15 last year to develop multi-modal connectivity through integrated planning and coordinated implementation of infrastructure connectivity projects.

A total of 16 Union ministries, including the railways and the roadways ministries, have been brought under the plan.

"Gati Shakti is not a scheme, but it is an initiative, a foundation. But it will not be an exaggeration if I say that it is a 'brahmastra'," Scindia said at an event here.

It is a "brahmastra" (powerful weapon) that will take India to the destination that the country's forefathers dreamt about, he added. Approximately 12-13% of the country's GDP is spent on logistics currently, Scindia noted.



A family is happy when every member carries out his duties, he said, adding that similarly, under Gati Shakti, 16 departments have been tied together so that each fulfills its responsibilities and uses resources judiciously to achieve its targets.

The National Master Plan will have a multiplier effect on the lives of people, the minister noted.

He said words like "gati" (speed) and "shakti" (strength) have been added to the country's dictionary after a gap of 70 years. The investments made by the United States in multi-modal logistics in the last 100 years has turned it into a super power, Scindia said.

"If we could bring all 36 states to work together and if we could develop coordination so that there is no delay in getting the requisite permissions, we will be able to achieve the aim of multi-modal connectivity," he added.

# ISMA revises upwards sugar output at 314.5 LT in 2021-22; export up at 16 LT in Oct-Dec

INDIA'S SUGAR PRODUCTION estimate has been revised upward by 3% to 314.5 lakh tonne (LT) for 2021-22 marketing year ending September as against the earlier forecast of 305 lakh tonne, according to industry body ISMA.

Sugar output stood at 311.8 lakh tonne in the 2020-21 season.

Releasing its second advance estimates, Indian Sugar Mills Association (ISMA) said, "The country is expected to produce 314.50 lakh tonne of sugar during 2021-22 season." Sugar marketing year runs from October to September.

"This is after considering an estimated diversion of sugar equivalent of 34 lakh tonne for production of ethanol by means of diversion of sugarcane juice



/syrup or B-heavy molasses," the association said in a statement on Monday.

Sugar production in Uttar Pradesh is seen at 102 lakh tonne in 2021-22 as against 110.59 lakh tonne in the previous year due to lower cane yields and lower sugar recoveries along with much higher diversion of sugar for production of ethanol

by way of diversion of B heavy molasses and sugarcane juice.

It is estimated that about 12.55 lakh tonne of sugar will be diverted for ethanol production by the sugar mills in UP in the current year as compared to about 6.90 lakh tonne diverted in 2020-21.

Maharashtra is expected to produce about 117 lakh tonne

in 2021-22 as against 106.50 lakh tonne produced in 2020-21.

Higher estimated sugar production this year is mainly due to increased cane area by about 11% and better cane yields and sugar recovery as compared to the last season.

"This is owing to favourable weather conditions as well as increase in percentage of ratoon cane, which helps in better recovery," ISMA said.

Based on the allocations made by the OMCs for supply of ethanol in 2021-22 so far and expected to be allocated in the current season, it is estimated that sugar mills in Maharashtra will divert about 11.27 lakh tonnes of sugar equivalent for production of ethanol in the current year, which is much higher as compared to about 7.12 lakh tonnes diverted in 2020-21.

# HC to DMRC: Take clear instructions on paying arbitral award to DAMEPL

THE DELHI HIGH COURT Monday asked the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) counsel to take clear instructions on how it will pay the amount of the arbitral award of over ₹4,600 crore to Reliance Infrastructure's subsidiary DAMEPL or else face an "unpleasant order."

Justice Suresh Kumar preponed the date of hearing relating to the execution of the arbitral award passed against the DMRC, from March 29 to February 14.

"Mr. (Parag) Tripathi (counsel for DMRC), on the next date of hearing, I don't want to hear anything here or there. You have to take clear instructions on how to pay the amount. This liability, that liability will not work otherwise you will face an unpleasant order," the judge said.

DMRC counsel assured the court that they will not seek any further accommodation. The high court was adjudicating an early hearing application filed by DAMEPL, in pursuance of the Supreme Court's January 24 order.

"The parties are directed to appear before the high court on January 31 and seek for advancing the date of hearing. We request the high court to take up the matter at the earliest and dispose of the execution application without any further delay, as consequences of pendency of this application are detrimental to the interest of the petitioner as well as the respondent," the apex court had said in its order while disposing of the appeal filed by DAMEPL challenging the high court's January 11 order.

On January 11, the high court had pulled up decree-holder DAMEPL for playing "hide and seek" with the court and holding out-of-court communications with judgement debtor DMRC to settle the dispute while arguing before the court that it was not ready to accept the proposal made by the PSU. Reliance Infrastructure's subsidiary had filed an application claiming that DMRC was deliberately trying to delay the execution of the over ₹4,600 crore arbitral award against it, which was costing the taxpayer a daily interest of almost ₹1.75 crore.

# Joshi: No need for separate discussion on Pegasus issue now, matter sub judice

PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS MINISTER Pralhad Joshi on Monday said there is no need for a separate discussion on the Pegasus issue now as the matter is sub-judice. However, if opposition parties want they can raise any issue while speaking on the Motion of Thanks on the president's address.

Parliamentary affairs minister Pralhad Joshi said opposition leaders are free to raise any issue while speaking on the Motion of Thanks on the President's address.

Addressing reporters after an all-party meeting held virtually, Joshi said the floor leaders of 25 parties attended the

meeting in which the government was represented by defence minister and deputy leader of Lok Sabha Rajnath Singh. Joshi said Singh sought cooperation from all parties for smooth functioning of the House during the Budget Session. As far as the Pegasus issue is concerned, he said, there is no need for a separate discussion now, but opposition leaders are free to raise any issue while speaking on the Motion

of Thanks on the President's address. The Budget session of Parliament began on Monday and is scheduled to conclude on April 8 with a recess in-between from February 12 to March 13.

The Pegasus issue was reignited after a recent *New York Times* report claimed that India bought the Pegasus spyware as part of a \$2 billion defence deal with Israel in 2017.

# Nobody losing anything due to vax mandates: Centre tells apex court

THE CENTRE ON Monday opposed in the Supreme Court the arguments that people are losing their jobs and rations allegedly due to the Covid-19 vaccine mandates issued by various states and authorities, saying nobody is "losing anything".

Solicitor general Tushar Mehta told this to a Bench comprising Justices L. Nageswara Rao

and B.R. Gavi that was hearing a matter in which issues including disclosure of data on clinical trials of Covid-19 vaccines and vaccine mandates have been raised.

Advocate Prashant Bhushan, appearing for the petitioner, said the aspect of vaccine mandates being issued by several states and other authorities is urgent as people are losing their jobs. Right now, what is urgent is the vaccine mandate because

people are losing their jobs. They are losing their rations. They are not able to move around freely as a result of these vaccine mandates," Bhushan said.

Mehta told the Bench that the petitioner has filed an application in the matter claiming that people are losing their jobs due to this. "Mr. Bhushan filed an IA that many people are losing their jobs etc. Nobody is losing anything and nobody has come before your lordships," Mehta

said. During the hearing, the Bench told Bhushan that all these instances, which the petitioner is bringing to its notice, might not be possible for the court to decide because there may be numerous situations.

The Bench said it would hear the matter finally and then decide it.

"Today, the situation is that people are losing their jobs," Bhushan said.

The Bench said there may be

so many situations and specific issues can be dealt with by the respective high courts.

Referring to the issue of vaccine mandates, Bhushan said various authorities are restricting all kinds of fundamental rights of the citizens by these mandates.

Bhushan said he was not arguing that vaccine mandate cannot be issued at all.

He said an individual has to weigh in the pros and cons of

vaccine, its benefits and then decide on it for himself or herself. He said such mandate can be issued only if there is clear evidence that not taking the vaccine makes an individual a much greater danger to others, than after taking the vaccine.

Bhushan said there is evidence to show that if a person had the infection, his or her protection from the infection is far superior than any protection that the vaccine might give.

आंकड़ों के मुताबिक, अभी तक इस साल अटल पेंशन योजना में 65 लाख लोगों ने नाम

दर्ज कराया है। जबकि पिछले साल यह आंकड़ा 80 लाख था। देश भर के रुझान के साथ ही बंगाल में भी लोगों का इस योजना से मोहभंग हो रहा है। पिछले वित्त वर्ष में बंगाल से सात लाख 59 हजार लोगों ने अटल पेंशन योजना में निवेश किया था। इस साल दिसंबर तक के आंकड़ों के मुताबिक, अभी तक चार लाख 43 हजार लोगों ने निवेश किया है। हालांकि, वित्त वर्ष समाप्त होने में समय बाकी है, लेकिन माना जा रहा है कि लोगों का योजना से मोहभंग हो गया है।

## केंद्र की मंजूरी नहीं मिलने के कारण 2,280 किलोमीटर ग्राम सड़क योजना अधर में

कोलकाता, 31 जनवरी (जनसत्ता)।

केंद्र सरकार की मंजूरी नहीं मिलने के कारण पश्चिम बंगाल में 2,280 किलोमीटर ग्राम सड़क योजना का काम अधर में लटक गया है। पंचायत विभाग के एक अधिकारी के मुताबिक, इससे फिर बंगाल को लेकर केंद्र का उपेक्षापूर्ण रवैया जाहिर हुआ है। अधिकारी के मुताबिक, राज्य में दो हजार 280 किलोमीटर लंबी सड़क के लिए मंजूरी मांगते हुए केंद्रीय ग्राम विकास मंत्रालय को विस्तारित परियोजना

रिपोर्ट (डीपीआर) भेजी गई थी। प्रस्तावित रास्ते के लिए कुल मिलाकर एक हजार 800 करोड़ का खर्च तय किया गया था। दिसंबर 2020 में रिपोर्ट भेजी गई लेकिन अभी तक एक किलोमीटर रास्ते के लिए भी मंजूरी प्रदान नहीं की गई। जबकि इसके बाद तीन बार केंद्र सरकार के प्रतिनिधि बंगाल के दौरे पर आए थे। परियोजना की समीक्षा के बाद भी कुछ नहीं किया गया।

जबकि इसके पहले वित्त वर्ष में ग्राम विकास मंत्रालय ने 294 अर्थात् दो हजार 500 किलोमीटर

रास्ते की मंजूरी प्रदान की थी। करीब दो हजार करोड़ रुपए की रकम इस मद में खर्च हुई थी। केंद्र सरकार के नियमों के मुताबिक, परियोजना में खर्च होने वाली राशि का 60 फीसद केंद्र और 40 फीसद राज्य सरकार ने दिया था। यह काम अंतिम चरण में है। राज्य के विधानसभा चुनाव में भाजपा की पराजय के बाद केंद्र का रवैया बदल गया है। राज्य सरकार के एक अधिकारी के मुताबिक, ग्रामीण सड़क योजना परियोजना में पश्चिम बंगाल बीते कई साल से देश में प्रथम स्थान हासिल कर रहा है।

## मेडिकल कालेज में काउंसिलिंग कल से होगी शुरू

कोलकाता, 31 जनवरी (जनसत्ता)।

# सिद्ध की हार पक्की: अमरिंदर

पटियाला शहरी से नामांकन दाखिल कर कहा, मुख्यमंत्री चन्नी के 111 दिन की उपलब्धियों के दावे झूठे चंडीगढ़, 31 जनवरी (जनसत्ता)।

पंजाब लोक कांग्रेस अध्यक्ष कैप्टन अमरिंदर सिंह ने राहुल गांधी की ओर से पंजाब में कांग्रेस के मुख्यमंत्री के चेहरे के शीघ्र पेलान संबंधी घोषणा को हास्यास्पद और बेबुनियाद बताया। उन्होंने कहा है कि अमृतसर पूर्व (ईस्ट) से कांग्रेस प्रत्याशी नवजोत सिंह सिद्ध की हार पक्की है। वैसे भी वह अब तक यहां से भाजपा के समर्थन से ही जीते रहे थे। अमरिंदर सिंह आज सोमवार को पटियाला शहरी से नामांकन दाखिल करने के बाद पत्रकारों से बातचीत कर रहे थे। उन्होंने सिद्ध के उस बयान को झूठ बताया जिसमें कहा गया है कि शिंदर द्वारा विक्रम सिंह मजिठिया को उनके खिलाफ खड़े करने के पीछे कैप्टन

अमरिंदर सिंह का हाथ है। उन्होंने कहा, 'मैं मजिठिया का अंकल नहीं हूँ जो ऐसा करूँ। अमृतसर पूर्व में 38 प्रतिशत मतदाता हिन्दू हैं और 32 प्रतिशत मतदाता अनुसूचित जाति के हैं इसलिए सिद्ध की हार पक्की है। भाजपा ने इस हलके में पंजाब लोकतांत्रिक कांग्रेस और शिंदर संयुक्त के साथ गठबंधन से एक मजबूत उम्मीदवार उतारा है।' अमरिंदर सिंह ने चुनावी जंग की शुरुआत करते हुए पार्टी कार्यकर्ताओं को राज्य के भविष्य को बचाने के लिए जुट जाने को कहा। उन्होंने कांग्रेस पर इन विधानसभा चुनावों को साढ़े 4 सालों की उनकी उपलब्धियों के आधार पर लड़ने का आरोप लगाया है। इस दौरान पार्टी कार्यकर्ताओं को संबोधित करते हुए पूर्व मुख्यमंत्री ने चरणजीत सिंह चन्नी द्वारा किए गए 111 दिनों में कांग्रेस के वादे पूरे करने संबंधी किए जा रहे दावों को झूठलाते हुए खुलासा किया कि जिन कामों को वे अपनी उपलब्धियां बता रहे हैं, वे उनकी

(अमरिंदर) सरकार द्वारा किए गए थे, जिनमें रोजगार पैदा करना, जनकल्याण योजनाएं लाना, महिलाओं के लिए मुफ्त बस सुविधा और किसानों के कर्ज माफी शामिल हैं। यहां तक कि बेअदबी और नशे के मामलों को लेकर उन पर कोई कार्रवाई न करने संबंधी लगाए जा रहे आरोपों, जिनके आधार पर उन्हें मुख्यमंत्री पद से हटाए जाने का दावा किया जा रहा है, के संबंध में उन्होंने कहा कि उनकी सरकार ने ही इन मामलों में सख्त कार्रवाई की थी। उन्होंने बेअदबी के मामलों को सीबीआइ से वापस लेने के लिए सुप्रीम कोर्ट तक सख्त लड़ाई लड़ी थी और इसके चलते पूर्व डीजीपी सुमेध सिंह सैनी सहित 19 अधिकारियों पर मामला दर्ज हुआ था। नशे के मामलों को लेकर पीएलसी नेता ने खुलासा किया कि उनकी सरकार ने सफलतापूर्वक नशा माफिया की कमर तोड़ दी थी और कई बड़ी मछलियों सहित 40000 से अधिक तस्करो को गिरफ्तारी हुई थी।

पंजाब में एक दिन में 30, हरियाणा में 19 मरीजों की कोरोना से मौत चंडीगढ़, 31 जनवरी (जनसत्ता)।

पंजाब में बीते 24 घंटों में कोरोना संक्रमण से कुल 30 लोगों की मौत हो गई जबकि 2415 नए मामले सामने आए हैं। वहीं, आज 2415 मरीज ठीक भी हुए हैं। प्रदेश में अब कुल 23,626 सक्रिय मामले बचे हैं जबकि अब तक कुल 17,253 लोगों की जान कोरोना से जा चुकी है। प्रदेश में आक्सीजन पर कुल 1,058 मरीज हो गए हैं वहीं, गंभीर हालत में जीवनरक्षक तंत्र पर 338 मरीज हैं। हरियाणा में कोरोना से एक दिन में 19 मरीजों की मौत हो गई जबकि कोरोना संक्रमण के 3563 नए मरीज आए हैं। प्रदेश में सबसे अधिक मामले 1155 मामले गुरुग्राम में आए हैं। प्रदेश में अब 25,567 मामले सक्रिय हैं जबकि कुल 10,305 लोगों की जान जा चुकी है। वहीं, चंडीगढ़ से सोमवार को कोरोना से चार लोगों की मौत हो गई जबकि 344 नए मामले सामने आए हैं। यहां अब तक कुल 3228 सक्रिय मामले बचे हैं जबकि आज 564 लोग ठीक भी हुए हैं।

नवांशहर: कांग्रेस टिकट न मिलने से खफा अंगद ने निर्दलीय तौर पर भरा परचा जलंधर, 31 जनवरी (जनसत्ता)।

नवांशहर विधानसभा हलके से कांग्रेस के निवर्तमान विधायक अंगद सिंह सैनी ने इस बार पार्टी टिकट न मिलने पर नाराज होकर आज सोमवार को निर्दलीय प्रत्याशी के तौर पर नामांकन दाखिल कर दिया। उन्होंने कहा, मुझे टिकट न देने की वजह मेरा काम नहीं बल्कि पत्नी के साथ चल रहे विवाद को बताया गया है। गौरतलब है कि अंगद की शादी रायबरेली की अदिति सिंह से हुई थी, जोकि उत्तर प्रदेश में भाजपा में शामिल हो गई हैं। अदिति ने 2019 में बंदी के दौरान प्रवासी मजदूरों के पलायन को लेकर प्रियंका गांधी पर भी निशाना साधा था। इस दौरान पत्रकारों से बातचीत में अंगद ने कहा, उनकी शादी उनकी मर्जी से हुई थी। लेकिन सभी शर्तियां सफल नहीं होती और उनके साथ भी ऐसा ही हुआ। उन्होंने कहा, 'मैं सार्वजनिक तौर पर अपने निजी जीवन के बारे में इसलिए बता रहा हूँ क्योंकि कांग्रेस पार्टी ने मुझे इसके लिए मजबूर कर दिया है। मैं तो हफ्तों तक दिल्ली में रहा लेकिन मेरी टिकट की घोषणा नहीं की गई। कांग्रेस के वरिष्ठ नेता मेरे काम की बजाय मेरी निजी जिंदगी की बात

पति-पत्नी की राजनीतिक पृष्ठभूमि आदिति और अंगद दोनों ही पहले ही चुनाव में विधायक बन गए थे। दोनों की पृष्ठभूमि राजनीतिक है। अंगद सैनी के पिता रव. प्रकाश सिंह सैनी इसी सीट से कांग्रेस के विधायक रहे हैं और अदिति के पिता स्व. अखिलेश प्रताप सिंह रायबरेली से विधायक रहे हैं। वर्ष 2017 में अंगद ने अपनी रिश्तेदार चरणजीत सिंह चन्नी के खिलाफ चुनाव लड़ा था जोकि अब आम आदमी के प्रत्याशी हैं। करते हैं। मैंने उन्हें बताया भी मैं और अदिति पिछले 14-15 महीनों से अलग रह रहे हैं। चुनावों के बाद ही हम कुछ फैसला करेंगे। लेकिन इसके बावजूद उन्होंने मुझे कहा कि मैं सोशल मीडिया पर अदिति के खिलाफ बयानबाजी करूँ ताकि उसकी बदनामी हो। मैंने उन्हें बोला, मुझे टिकट मिले या न मिले पर मैं किसी महिला को बेइज्जत नहीं करूंगा। मेरी मां ने यही सिखाया है कि किसी भी महिला का अपमान नहीं करना चाहिए।' इससे पहले आज अंगद के समर्थक उनके घर पर इकट्ठा हुए और उन्होंने निर्दलीय लड़ने की बात कही। समर्थकों के कहने पर ही अंगद ने निर्दलीय प्रत्याशी के तौर पर अपना परचा भरा।

## वाट्सऐप के जरिए 24 से अधिक को ठगा

जनसत्ता संवाददाता नई दिल्ली, 31 जनवरी।

कोरोना के एहतियातन खुराक (बूस्टर डोज) के नाम पर लोगों के वाट्सऐप हैक कर धोखाधड़ी करने का मामला सामने आया है। दिल्ली पुलिस की विशेष प्रकोष्ठ ने एक ऐसे ही गिरोह का पर्दाफाश किया है।

यह गिरोह 24 से अधिक लोगों को इस प्रकार से निशाना बना चुके हैं। आरोपियों की पहचान मनीष कुमार, रोहित और कौशलेंद्र के तौर पर की गई है। पुलिस ने इनकी निशानदेही पर डेबिट कार्ड, चेक बुक, मोबाइल फोन और अन्य महत्वपूर्ण दस्तावेज बरामद किए हैं।

उपरोक्त केपीएस मल्होत्रा के मुताबिक टीम को एक शिकायत मिली थी कि बूस्टर डोज के नाम पर ठगी की गई है। पीड़ित को एक नंबर से फोन करके बताया गया था कि उसे यह खुराक लगनी है। फिर उसे कॉन्फ्रेंस पर फोन करने के लिए कहा गया। इस दौरान उसके मोबाइल पर एक 'वाट्सऐप अकाउंट चेंज कोड' भेजा गया। इस तरह उसके मोबाइल को हैक कर लिया गया। इसके बाद उनके परिचितों को मैसेज भेजकर मदद के तौर पर रुपए मांगे गए। पीड़ित के भाई ने खाते में

50 हजार रुपए भेज दिए। छानबीन में पता चला कि साइबर क्राइम पोर्टल पर भी इस तरह की 20 से ज्यादा शिकायतें पहुंची हुई हैं। टीम ने मामला दर्ज कर जांच शुरू की तो पता चला कि फोन करने वाला शख्स मनीष कुमार है। उसके बाद आगरा में छापा मारकर उसके दो साथियों रोहित और कौशलेंद्र सिंह समेत तीनों को गिरफ्तार किया गया और फोन करने के लिए इस्तेमाल किए गए मोबाइल फोन को जब्त किया गया।

पूछताछ के दौरान आरोपी मनीष कुमार ने पुलिस को बताया कि करीब एक साल पहले उसने यू-ट्यूब पर देखा था कि किस तरीके से वाट्सऐप को हैक किया जाता है। इसके बाद वह लोगों के साथ ठगी करने लगा। आरोपियों को पता था कि बूस्टर डोज लगवाने के लिए लोग तैयार हैं और उन्हें फोन कर असानी से चूना लगाया जा सकता है। जांच में पता चला है कि आरोपी मनीष कुमार के खिलाफ छेड़छाड़ के तीन मामले पहले से दर्ज हैं। इनकी निशानदेही पर चार डेबिट कार्ड, एक चेक बुक और मोबाइल फोन जब्त किया है। इसके अलावा इनके 8 बैंक खातों को फ्रीज कर दिया गया है। अभी तक ठगी के 24 मामलों की जानकारी मिली है।

## MULTI-MODAL NETWORK Scindia urges Centre, states to work together for Gati Shakti success

**THE MULTI-MODAL** connectivity envisaged under "PM Gati Shakti" will be achieved if the Centre and all the 36 states and Union territories work together, aviation minister Jyotiraditya Scindia said on Monday.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched "PM Gati Shakti - National Master Plan" on August 15 last year to develop multi-modal connectivity through integrated planning and coordinated implementation of infrastructure connectivity projects.

A total of 16 Union ministries, including the railways and the roadways ministries, have been brought under the plan.

"Gati Shakti is not a scheme, but it is an initiative, a foundation. But it will not be an exaggeration if I say that it is a 'brahmastra'," Scindia said at an event here.

It is a "brahmastra" (powerful weapon) that will take India to the destination that the country's forefathers dreamt about, he added. Approximately 12-13% of the country's GDP is spent on logistics currently, Scindia noted.

A family is happy when every member carries out his duties, he said, adding that similarly, under Gati Shakti, 16 departments have been tied together so that each fulfils its responsibilities and uses resources judiciously to achieve its targets.

The National Master Plan will have a multiplier effect on the lives of people, the minister noted.

He said words like "gati" (speed) and "shakti" (strength) have been added to the country's dictionary after a gap of 70 years. The investments made by the United States in multi-modal logistics in the last 100 years has turned it into a super power, Scindia said.

"If we could bring all 36 states to work together and if we could develop coordination so that there is no delay in getting the requisite permissions, we will be able to achieve the aim of multi-modal connectivity," he added.

## ISMA revises upwards sugar output at 314.5 LT in 2021-22; export up at 16 LT in Oct-Dec

**INDIA'S SUGAR PRODUCTION** estimate has been revised upward by 3% to 314.5 lakh tonne (LT) for 2021-22 marketing year ending September as against the earlier forecast of 305 lakh tonne, according to industry body ISMA.

Sugar output stood at 311.8 lakh tonne in the 2020-21 season.

Releasing its second advance estimates, Indian Sugar Mills Association (ISMA) said, "The country is expected to produce 314.50 lakh tonne of sugar during 2021-22 season." Sugar marketing year runs from October to September.

"This is after considering an estimated diversion of sugar equivalent of 34 lakh tonne for production of ethanol by means of diversion of sugarcane juice



/syrup or B-heavy molasses," the association said in a statement on Monday.

Sugar production in Uttar Pradesh is seen at 102 lakh tonne in 2021-22 as against 110.59 lakh tonne in the previous year due to lower cane yields and lower sugar recoveries along with much higher diversion of sugar for production of ethanol

by way of diversion of B heavy molasses and sugarcane juice.

It is estimated that about 12.55 lakh tonne of sugar will be diverted for ethanol production by the sugar mills in UP in the current year, which is much higher as compared to about 6.90 lakh tonne diverted in 2020-21.

Maharashtra is expected to produce about 117 lakh tonne

in 2021-22 as against 106.50 lakh tonne produced in 2020-21.

Higher estimated sugar production this year is mainly due to increased cane area by about 11% and better cane yields and sugar recovery as compared to the last season.

"This is owing to favourable weather conditions as well as increase in percentage of ratoon cane, which helps in better recovery," ISMA said.

Based on the allocations made by the OMCs for supply of ethanol in 2021-22 so far and expected to be allocated in the current season, it is estimated that sugar mills in Maharashtra will divert about 11.27 lakh tonnes of sugar equivalent for production of ethanol in the current year, which is much higher as compared to about 7.12 lakh tonnes diverted in 2020-21.

## Joshi: No need for separate discussion on Pegasus issue now, matter sub judice

Addressing reporters after an all-party meeting held virtually, Joshi said the floor leaders of 25 parties attended the

meeting in which the government was represented by defence minister and deputy leader of Lok Sabha Rajnath Singh. Joshi said Singh sought cooperation from all parties for smooth functioning of the House during the Budget Session. As far as the Pegasus issue is concerned, he said, there is no need for a separate discussion now, but opposition leaders are free to raise any issue while speaking on the Motion

of Thanks on the President's address. The Budget session of Parliament began on Monday and is scheduled to conclude on April 8 with a recess in-between from February 12 to March 13.

The Pegasus issue was reignited after a recent *New York Times* report claimed that India bought the Pegasus spyware as part of a \$2 billion defence deal with Israel in 2017.

## Nobody losing anything due to vax mandates: Centre tells apex court

**THE CENTRE ON** Monday opposed in the Supreme Court the arguments that people are losing their jobs and rations allegedly due to the Covid-19 vaccine mandates issued by various states and authorities, saying nobody is "losing anything". Solicitor general Tushar Mehta told this to a Bench comprising Justices L Nageswara Rao

and B R Gavai that was hearing a matter in which issues including disclosure of data on clinical trials of Covid-19 vaccines and vaccine mandates have been raised.

Advocate Prashant Bhushan, appearing for the petitioner, said the aspect of vaccine mandates being issued by several states and other authorities is urgent as people are losing their jobs. Right now, what is urgent is the vaccine mandate because

people are losing their jobs. They are losing their rations. They are not able to move around freely as a result of these vaccine mandates," Bhushan said.

Mehta told the Bench that the petitioner has filed an application in the matter claiming that people are losing their jobs due to this. "Mr Bhushan filed an IA that many people are losing their jobs etc. Nobody is losing anything and nobody has come before your lordships," Mehta

said. During the hearing, the Bench told Bhushan that all these instances, which the petitioner is bringing to its notice, might not be possible for the court to decide because there may be numerous situations.

The Bench said it would hear the matter finally and then decide it.

"Today, the situation is that people are losing their jobs," Bhushan said.

The Bench said there may be

so many situations and specific issues can be dealt with by the respective high courts.

Referring to the issue of vaccine mandates, Bhushan said various authorities are restricting all kinds of fundamental rights of the citizens by these mandates.

Bhushan said he was not arguing that vaccine mandate cannot be issued at all.

He said an individual has to weigh in the pros and cons of

vaccine, its benefits and then decide on it for himself or herself. He said such mandate can be issued only if there is clear evidence that not taking the vaccine makes an individual a much greater danger to others, than after taking the vaccine.

Bhushan said there is evidence to show that if a person had the infection, his or her protection from the infection is far superior than any protection that the vaccine might give.

## HC to DMRC: Take clear instructions on paying arbitral award to DAMEPL

**THE DELHI HIGH COURT** Monday asked the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) counsel to take clear instructions on how it will pay the amount of the arbitral award of over ₹4,600 crore to Reliance Infrastructure's subsidiary DAMEPL or else face an "unpleasant order".

Justice Suresh Kumar Kait preponed the date of hearing relating to the execution of the arbitral award passed against the DMRC, from March 29 to February 14.

"Mr. (Parag) Tripathi (counsel for DMRC), on the next date of hearing, I don't want to hear anything here or there. You have to take clear instructions on how to pay the amount. This liability, that liability will not work otherwise you will face an unpleasant order," the judge said.

DMRC counsel assured the court that they will not seek any further accommodation. The high court was adjudicating an early hearing application filed by DAMEPL, in pursuance of the Supreme Court's January 24 order.

"The parties are directed to appear before the high court on January 31 and seek for advancing the date of hearing. We request the high court to take up the matter at the earliest and dispose of the execution application without any further delay, as consequences of pendency of this application are detrimental to the interest of the petitioner as well as the respondent," the apex court had said in its order while disposing of the appeal filed by DAMEPL challenging the high court's January 11 order.

On January 11, the high court had pulled up decree-holder DAMEPL for playing "hide and seek" with the court and holding out-of-court communications with judgement debtor DMRC to settle the dispute while arguing before the court that it was not ready to accept the proposal made by the PSU, Reliance Infrastructure's subsidiary had filed an application claiming that DMRC was deliberately trying to delay the execution of the over ₹4,600 crore arbitral award against it, which was costing the taxpayer a daily interest of almost ₹1.75 crore.

इन उम्मीदवारों में सबसे प्रमुख नाम गायत्री तिवारी का है, जो बहुचर्चित बिकरू कांड के बाद गिरफ्तार की गईं खुशी दुबे की मां हैं। गायत्री को कानपुर के कल्याणपुर से टिकट दिया गया है। कांग्रेस सूत्रों का कहना है कि गायत्री तिवारी ने हाल में पार्टी महासचिव प्रियंका गांधी वाड़ा से मुलाकात की थी, जिसके बाद उन्हें टिकट दिया गया है ताकि 'खुशी दुबे को इंसाफ मिल सके।' पार्टी सूत्रों ने कहा कि बिकरू कांड से दो दिन पहले ही खुशी दुबे शादी करके ससुराल आई थी, लेकिन उसे भी जेल में डाल दिया गया। अगर घटना के दो दिन पहले ही उसकी शादी हुई थी तो फिर वह पति द्वारा किए गए अपराध में कैसे शामिल हो सकती है? खुशी दुबे के साथ इंसाफ होना चाहिए। यह कांग्रेस की उत्तर प्रदेश विधानसभा चुनाव के लिये उम्मीदवारों की पांचवीं सूची है। कांग्रेस उत्तर प्रदेश में अब तक कुल 322 उम्मीदवार घोषित कर चुकी है, जिनमें कुल 130 महिलाओं को टिकट दिया गया है।

युवक को रविवार को गिरफ्तार किया गया। गिरफ्तार युवक की पहचान फूल सिंह (40) के रूप में हुई है।

उन्होंने बताया कि फूल सिंह कैसर जैसी गंभीर बीमारी ठीक करने के बहाने ईसाई धर्म स्वीकार करने दबाव बना रहा था, जिसे हिंदू संगठनों की सूचना पर रविवार को गिरफ्तार किया गया और सुसंगत धाराओं के तहत मामला दर्ज कर उसे सोमवार को जेल भेज दिया गया। धर्म परिवर्तन को लेकर हिंदू संगठनों में गुस्सा है।

# HC to DMRC: Take clear instructions on paying arbitral award to DAMEPL

**THE DELHI HIGH** Court Monday asked the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) counsel to take clear instructions on how it will pay the amount of the arbitral award of over ₹4,600 crore to Reliance Infrastructure's subsidiary DAMEPL or else face an "unpleasant order."

Justice Suresh Kumar Kait preponed the date of hearing relating to the execution of the arbitral award passed against the DMRC, from March 29 to February 14.

"Mr. (Parag) Tripathi (counsel for DMRC), on the next date of hearing, I don't want to hear anything here or there. You have to take clear instructions on how to pay the amount. This liability,

that liability will not work otherwise you will face an unpleasant order," the judge said.

DMRC counsel assured the court that they will not seek any further accommodation. The high court was adjudicating an early hearing application filed by DAMEPL, in pursuance of the Supreme Court's January 24 order.

"The parties are directed to appear before the high court on January 31 and seek for advancing the date of hearing. We request the high court to take up the matter at the earliest and dispose of the execution application without any further delay, as consequences of pendency of this application are detrimental to the interest of the petitioner as well as the respondent," the apex court



had said in its order while disposing of the appeal filed by DAMEPL challenging the high court's January 11 order.

On January 11, the high court had pulled up decreeholder DAMEPL for playing "hide and seek" with the court and holding out-of-court communications with judgement debtor DMRC to settle the dispute while arguing before the court that it was not ready to

accept the proposal made by the PSU.

Reliance Infrastructure's subsidiary had filed an application claiming that DMRC was deliberately trying to delay the execution of the over ₹4,600 crore arbitral award against it, which was costing the taxpayer a daily interest of almost ₹1.75 crore.

An arbitral tribunal in its May 2017 award had ruled in favour of DAMEPL, which had pulled out from running the Airport Express metro line over safety issues, and accepted its claim that the running of operations on the line was not viable due to structural defects in the viaduct through which the train would run.

In December last year, DAMEPL's counsel had told the

court that as per DMRC's affidavit, it had over ₹5,800 crore in its bank accounts as of December 17, 2021, with over ₹1,642 crore being its earning and over ₹2,400 crore and ₹1,700 crore being its project allocation fund and deposit fund, respectively. DMRC had stated that since the corporation was facing a "financial crunch", undertaking a "sudden liability" would impact public interest and authorities were therefore working out a solution. It had earlier told the court that it would deposit ₹1,000 crore in favour of DAMEPL in an escrow account.

The award pertained to a concession agreement between the two entities, which was signed on August 25, 2008. Under the agreement, DMRC was to carry out the civil works, excluding at the depot, and the balance, including the project system works, were to be executed by DAMEPL, a joint venture of R-Infra and a Spanish construction company - Construcciones Y Auxiliares De Ferrocarriles - with a shareholding of 95% and 5% respectively.

The Airport Express line was commissioned on February 23, 2011, after an investment of over ₹2,885 crore, funded by the DAMEPL promoters' fund, banks, and financial institutions. In November 2021, the Supreme Court had dismissed DMRC's plea seeking a review of its judgement which upheld the 2017 arbitration award in favour of DAMEPL, enforceable against it.

# Power sector workers to hold nationwide protest today against privatisation

**ALL INDIA POWER** Engineers Federation (AIPEF) has said power sector workers will hold a nationwide protest against privatisation policies on Tuesday.

"On the call of National Coordination Committee of Electricity Employees & Engineers (NCCOEEE) Power Employees & Engineers across the country will hold protest demonstrations against privatisation policies of Central Government," an AIPEF statement said.

NCCOEEE has also decided that core committee leaders of NCCOEEE will meet the Punjab Governor on February 1 and hand over a memorandum to him against the privatisation of Chandigarh UT Power Department. NCCOEEE core committee office bearers will address the strike rally of Puducherry power employees on February 2 at Puducherry.

AIPEF Chairman Shailendra Dubey said, "On-call of NCCOEEE about 1.5 million Power Employees & Engineers across the country will hold nationwide protest/ demon-

strations on February 1 at all district headquarters and projects against privatisation policies of Central Government".

The main demand of Power Employees & Engineers are - withdraw Electricity (Amendment) Bill 2021, scrap decision of privatisation of profit-making power departments of Union Territories -- Chandigarh, Dadra Nagar Haveli Daman & Diu and Puducherry, integrate all unbundled power utilities in states like KSEB Ltd in Kerala and HPSEB Ltd in Himachal Pradesh, implement old pension scheme for all power employees recruited after unbundling of SEBs, regularise all outsourced power employees as the Telangana government has done, he added. Dubey said that NCCOEEE core committee leaders will reach Chandigarh on February 1 to support UT Power Employees Strike against privatisation. The leaders will meet the governor on February 1 and submit a memorandum to him against the privatisation of the profit-making power department. —PTI

# Nobody losing anything due to vax mandates: Centre tells apex court

**THE CENTRE ON** Monday opposed in the Supreme Court the arguments that people are losing their jobs and rations allegedly due to the Covid-19 vaccine mandates issued by various states and authorities, saying nobody is "losing anything".

Solicitor general Tushar Mehta told this to a Bench comprising Justices L. Nageswara Rao and B.R. Gavai that was hearing a matter in which issues including disclosure of data on clinical trials of Covid-19 vaccines and vaccine mandates have been raised.

Advocate Prashant Bhushan, appearing for the petitioner, said the aspect of vaccine mandates being issued by several states and other authorities is urgent as people are losing their jobs.

"Right now, what is urgent is the vaccine mandate because people are losing their jobs. They are losing their rations. They are not able to move around freely as a result of these vaccine mandates," Bhushan said.

Mehta told the Bench that the petitioner has filed an application in the matter claiming that people are losing their jobs due to this.

"Mr Bhushan filed an IA that many people are losing their jobs etc. Nobody is losing anything and nobody has come before your lordships," Mehta said.

During the hearing, the Bench told Bhushan that all these instances, which the petitioner is bringing to its notice, might not be possible for the court to decide because there may be numerous situations.

The Bench said it would hear the matter finally and then decide it.

"Today, the situation is that people are losing their jobs," Bhushan said.

The Bench said there may be so many situations and specific issues can be dealt with by the respective high courts.

Referring to the issue of vaccine mandates, Bhushan said various authorities are restricting all kinds of fundamental rights of the citizens by these mandates.

Bhushan said he was not arguing that vaccine mandate cannot be issued at all.

He said an individual has to weigh in the pros and cons of vaccine, its benefits and then decide on it for himself or herself.

He said such mandate can be issued only if there is clear evidence that not taking the vaccine makes an individual a much greater danger to others, than after taking the vaccine.

Bhushan said there is evidence to show that if a person had the infection, his or her protection from the infection is far superior than any protection that the vaccine might give. The Bench said it will list the matter for hearing finally and decide it.

The apex court had in August last year asked the Centre, Bharat Biotech, Serum Institute of India and others to respond to the plea seeking directions for disclosure of data on clinical trials of Covid-19 vaccines as also on post-jab cases. Bhushan had then told the court that it was not an "anti-vaccine petition" and transparency on the issue was needed.

# Joshi: No need for separate discussion on Pegasus issue, matter sub judice

**PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS MINISTER** Pralhad Joshi on Monday said there is no need for a separate discussion on the Pegasus issue now as the matter is sub-judice. However, if opposition parties want they can raise any issue while speaking on the Motion of Thanks on the president's address, he said.

Addressing reporters after an all-party meeting held virtually, Joshi said the floor leaders of 25 parties attended the meeting in which the government was represented by defence minister and deputy leader of Lok Sabha Rajnath Singh. Joshi said Singh sought cooperation from all parties for smooth functioning of the House during the Budget Session.

As far as the Pegasus issue is concerned, he said, there is no need for a separate discussion now, but opposition leaders are free to raise any issue while speaking on the Motion of Thanks on the President's address. The Budget session of Parliament began on Monday.

# Scindia urges Centre, states to work together for Gati Shakti success

**THE MULTI-MODAL** connectivity envisaged under "PM Gati Shakti" will be achieved if the Centre and all the 36 states and Union territories work together, aviation minister Jyotiraditya Scindia said on Monday.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched "PM Gati Shakti - National Master Plan" on August 15 last year to develop multi-modal connectivity through integrated planning and coordinated implementation of infrastructure connectivity projects.

"Gati Shakti is not a scheme, but it is an initiative, a foundation. But it will not be an exaggeration if I say that it is a 'brahmastra'," Scindia said at an event here.

It is a "brahmastra" (powerful weapon) that will take India to the destination that the country's forefathers dreamt about, he added. Approximately 12-13% of the country's GDP is

spent on logistics currently, Scindia noted.

A family is happy when every member carries out his duties, he said, adding that similarly, under Gati Shakti, 16 departments have been tied together so that each fulfils its responsibilities and uses resources judiciously to achieve its targets.

The National Master Plan will have a multiplier effect on the lives of people, the minister noted.

He said words like "gati" (speed) and "shakti" (strength) have been added to the country's dictionary after a gap of 70 years. The investments made by the United States in multi-modal logistics in the last 100 years has turned it into a super power, Scindia said.

"If we could bring all 36 states to work together and if we could develop coordination so that there is no delay in getting the requisite permissions, we will be able to achieve the aim of multi-modal connectivity," he added.
